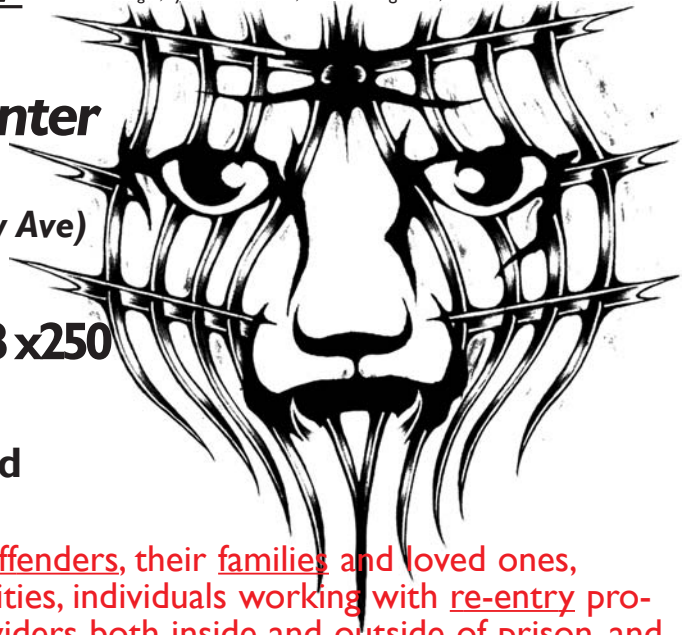

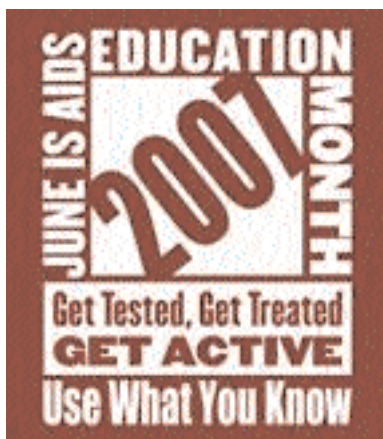
Caged, By William DuBeck, Books Through Bars, Contexts Collection
